

Community Tennis

Mission: To provide access to junior players who do not have the financial means for club membership or ongoing tournament play. This program will bridge the gap by providing match play for beginning to intermediate level players allowing them to develop their competitive experience and prepare for high school varsity competition.

Target Players: Girls & boys from high C squad, JV, and varsity players from the Twin Cities metro area and surrounding suburbs

Format: Pods of 20 players on a rotating schedule, playing every third weekend. Each weekend event will include playing two, timed singles matches and one doubles match. The [*Universal Tennis Rating*](#) (UTR) format will be used to record each week's matches on the website. **Each player in the program will be guaranteed at least 18 matches (12 singles; 6 doubles) over the course of the winter.** A doubles tie-breaker tournament will be played for each pod's final session.

Program Cost:

Approximate cost for the entire winter season (November - March) is **\$320**

- **\$200 initial payment** which covers:
 - > administration and coordination of the schedule,
 - > court reservations,
 - > website maintenance, and
 - > match coaching/analysis from USPTA & PTR Teaching Pros
- **\$20/player** to be paid every weekend played which covers:
 - > supervision/match management,
 - > subsidized court fee,
 - > coaching and
 - > match balls.
